Creation Era

Memory Verse: Proverbs 28:13 – “He who covers his sins will not prosper. But whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy.”

Prayer Focus: As we begin this study ask God to give you insight into His Word.

The following are questions that you will be discussing next Wednesday. Read the scripture aloud in your small group.

1. Where does God place man?

2. What are God’s instructions to man?

3. What does this tell you about God?

4. Why does God bring animals to Adam?

5. What does this do for Adam?

6. How does God provide a mate for Adam and what purpose does she serve?

7. How does Adam describe the woman?

8. How is the couple described and what does God require of the couple?

9. How is the serpent described?

10. Where does the serpent come from? (Isaiah 14:12-14)

11. Whom does the serpent approach? Why?

12. What is the first thing the serpent says to the woman?

13. What is the serpent's goal?

14. What happens after the couple eats the fruit?

15. What does sin cost creation? Man? Woman? God? The Serpent?

16. What does God do that gives hope?

17. Does God continue to allow Adam and Eve to wear leaves for covering? Why not?

18. What does God declare after He created animal life? What did it cost God to cover man? (It is important for participants to understand what it cost God – something that was good and that He delighted in – to cover man’s sin.)

19. Did God allow man to remain in the garden? Why not?

20. What does this tell you about God? Sin?
