Scripture Exodus 1-2

The Exodus Era

Exodus takes up where Genesis leaves off. The period between Joseph and Moses is covered by two verses, Exodus 1:6-7 were the new situation of the descendants of Jacob, is described. The guests of Pharaoh and Joseph become a nation of slaves. In Exodus, God acts through a man named Moses to deliver His people.

This era began with God preparing Moses to fulfill the promise that He made to Abraham in Genesis 15 regarding the nation's future. Moses sensed his providential placement in Pharaoh's household but prematurely and unsuccessfully moved on his people's behalf. Forty years in the wilderness, however, stripped Moses of his confidence and prepared him to lead Israel out of bondage.

Memory Verse: Isaiah 12:2 – "See God has come to save me. I will trust in Him and not be afraid. The Lord God is my strength and my song; He has given me victory."
