Exodus 11-12:1-30

Exodus Era

God slowly but surely fulfills His promise made to Abraham in Genesis 15 regarding his descendents. God could have delivered Israel out of Egypt in a myriad of ways, but He chose to work through one man, Moses, to deliver His people. God's method of preparing leaders for His tasks differs from that of man's. Moses learned things about himself, people, and God in the wilderness, that he could not have learned from a book on leadership. God's task always requires God's preparation of those who He chooses to use.

Memory Verse: 2 Corinthians 3:15- For we are to God the fragrance of Christ among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing.

Prayer Focus: God has chosen to work through us, ask the Lord to enable you to be the fragrance of Christ to those around you.

2. What instructions does Moses give the people after the announcement regarding the final plague? (Exodus 11:2-3)

3. What had God told Abraham regarding this exodus from bondage. (Genesis 15:12-14, 18-21)

4. What does this tell you about God?

5. What specific instruction does God give the children of Israel before they leave Egypt? (Exodus 12:3)

6. What does God say will happen at mid-night? (Ex. 11:4-5; Ex. 12:12)

7. Exodus 12:3-4. What instructions does God give that are to be carried out on the tenth of the month?

8. Upon what basis is the lamb chosen? (Ex. 12:5) What does this tell you about God?

9. How many days are they to observe the lamb before it is slain? Why do you think the Lord had them keep the lamb for this length of time?

10. What are they to do with the lamb on the fourteenth day? (Ex. 12:6-7)

11. What is the blood's importance? (Adam and Eve- Gen. 3:21; Abel- Gen. 4:4; Noah- Gen. 8; Abraham- Gen. 22:2)

12. What are they to do next with the Lamb? (Ex. 12:8-10)

13. What does the Lord call this last meal?

14. What does God promise He will do for Israel?(Ex. 12:13) To Egypt? (Ex. 12:12)

15. What was the Feast of Unleaven Bread? (Ex. 12:14)

16. What is a memorial?

17. Why does God instruct the people to celebrate the Passover continually?

18. Who all come up out of Egypt? What does this tell you about God?
