

## Week 18 Questions

### Exodus 12:31-50; 13:1-21; 14:1-30

There arose in the night a great cry in Egypt for there was not a house where there was not one dead.

Pharaoh just wanted the Israelites out of his sight. The loss of his firstborn has broken him for the moment, but his heart again hardens and he is in hot pursuit.

Will the Israelites trust God when the heat is on?

**Memory Verse:** Trust in the Lord, with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths. Proverbs 3:5-6

**Prayer Focus:** May I trust even when I don't understand.

Pharaoh had one last encounter with Moses and Aaron. He had declared that Moses would die if they met again but he could not keep that resolve. Instead he gave unconditional release of all the Israelites to go and worship.
